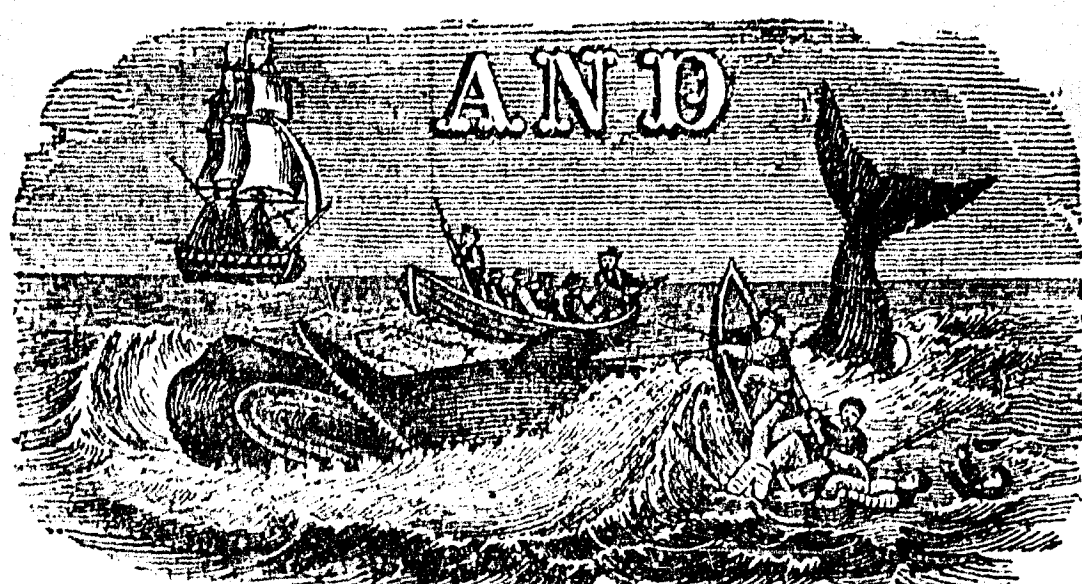

Boston Shipping List, Price Current, and underwriters Gazette.—This is the title of a publication recently commenced in Boston, by Learned Haven & Co. It is designed to be an advocate of the mercantile and commercial interest of Boston, by presenting to the merchants of the West, South and East, and the mercantile community in general, a true report of its markets and general business facilities. It is published on Wednesday and Saturday of each week, at No 86, State street, Boston. The style in which it is got up indicates that there is industry and talent engaged in the enterprise, richly deserving the patronage of the mercantile community.

MEMORANDA.

The schr Zenobia, Capt Owen, which arrived at this port on Sunday, from Baltimore, reports that on Thursday Sept 7th, it blowing very heavy, Samuel Maffitt, of Talbot Co. Md., was lost overboard from the flying jib-boom, and all efforts to save him were in vain, as he sunk in a few minutes. On the afternoon of the same day the wind blowing a hurricane, a schooner run down and hove too, about two hundred yards to windward of them, with a signal of distress flying. It falling calm for three or four minutes, the distressed vessel lowered her boat, and the crew of 5 or 6 men got into her, but at the same time the wind shifted to the opposite quarter and blew violently again, bringing the Z. to windward of her. The Z's helm was immediately put up with the intention of running down to them, but when within 50 yards of their weather quarter, the boat shoved off, and was immediately swamped and capsized, and by the time the Z. could be brought to the wind, (having no sail set) was about 40 yards to windward of them, three of the men holding on by her keel and the other two swimming. Every exertion was made to render the assistance but it was impossible before they had all gone down. In about 30 minutes after, the schr sunk, in seven fathoms of water, Cape May bearing NW., distant 15 miles. The schooner's name began with S. and she belonged to Bath. She was painted black with a broad yellow streak, squaresail furled to her lower yard, and had a standing fore top gallant yard aloft.

The brig Sarah Louisa, of this port, which sailed 14th for Atlantic Ocean, returned same day in consequence of a bad leak in the bows.

Ship Illinois and bark Francia of New York, have been sold for whalers, to what port not stated.

The ship Nantasket, of New London, at Fayal July 12, landed Nathaniel G. Robinson of Boston, sick.

The brig James Munroe, of Plymouth, at Princess Island June 16, had lost five men by sickness, and the remainder of her crew were sick.

Was passed Sept 3, '43, lat 40 80, lon 70 12, a ship (supposed a whaler) steering SE., when passing she hoisted to her mizen peak, a blue signal with red lower edge and letter H. in the middle.

NEW-BEDFORD OIL MARKET.

[For the week ending September 18, 1843.]

Sperm.—The transactions during the week consist of sales of Sperm here and in the adjoining towns, to the extent of 3,600 bbls, generally at 70 cents, cash. One parcel of 270 bbls dark color, was sold at 69 cts; and a parcel of 300 bbls, extra per centage of head, at 71 cents.

Whale.—We have heard of only one sale of whale, at 37 cents; and of no action in whale bone.

NEW-YORK MARKET—SEPTEMBER 16.

CANDLES.—New Bedford Sperm are scarce, in request, and have advanced one cent; 150 bxs. have been taken for shipment at 31 cents, 4 mos.

COPPER.—New Sheathing is steady at 21 cents, 6 mos; we understand a further small sale of Peruvian Pig has been made at 16 cents.

FLOUR.—On Wednesday and Thursday, particularly Wednesday, there continued a good demand for Western Flour, partly speculative, but mostly for the Eastern market, and a further advance of about 6½ cents per bbl. was realized on Genesee, that from new Wheat selling freely afloat at \$4,56½ @ \$4,62½, and from store several thousand bbls, were taken at \$4,56½. At the close of Thursday and yesterday, there was a suspension of demand, partly owing to unfavourable weather, and fresh Genesee could have been purchased at \$4,56½, thus leaving prices precisely as at the close of business Tuesday. Michigan and Ohio are not plenty, and may be quoted \$4,50, with sales to a moderate extent, including 500 bbls.

GRAIN.—Northern Rye, owing to its scarcity, has advanced 2½ cents; 1500 bushels sold to arrive, on private terms; and 3000 do. mostly to arrive, at 65 cents, delivered. Northern Oats are in fair supply and demand at 26 @ 28½ cents for River and Canal 300 bush. Southern sold at 22 cents cash. Corn remains inactive, but prices have not varied particularly; the sales are 2500 bushels Northern, at 56 cents; 1800 Ohio, in the slip, 50, both measure; 1126 Virginia, 53 cents, to be taken from the vessel; and 3000 Ohio, one-half to arrive, 54½, weight.

HAY.—The sales of North River are about 1500 bales old and new, part from store, at 40 @ 45 cents. The stock by sales and shipments is much reduced.

IRON.—A sale of 50 tons English Bar has been made from the vessel at \$51,50, 6 mos.

NAVAL STORES.—There is very little if any good Turpentine here, and, consequently, we have no sales to report. Spirits Turpentine may be quoted 39 @ 40 cents, 4 mos. at which price the market is firm. Tar and Rosin continue inactive.

OILS.—Whale is dull, and 500 bbls. South Sea taken for export yesterday at 36½ cents cash, shows a slight reduction. Linseed remains inactive, and sales have been made at lower rates; 15 bbls. Ohio brought 80 cents cash. Of Cruse Sperm, 130 bbls, here sold at 71 cents; and 500 do. at New Bedford, for manufacturing here, on terms not made public. 50 bskts. Marseilles Olive sold at \$3,75, 4 mos.; and 283 do. \$3,62½, cash, less one per cent.

PROVISIONS.—Our reduced quotations for Beef are entirely nominal, there being no demand at present. Ohio Pork is dull, with a tendency to decline; the sales are 500 bbls. Prime, on private terms; a like quantity, in lots, at \$11 @ \$11.25 for mess and \$10.12½ for Prime; and 50 bbls. sour Prime, \$8.12½. Mess is offered freely at \$11, and Prime in lots of 500 bbls. at \$10, without finding buyers; 2200 bbls. new Ohio of the coming season have been sold, deliverable any time before the 15th May, 1844, at \$10.50 for Mess, and \$8.50 for Prime.

WHALEBONE.—There has been nothing done for export since our last; buyers anxiously await later advices from abroad, they paying present high rates very reluctantly.

The fees for Pilotage are established at one dollar fifty cents per foot for outward bound vessels, and two dollars for vessels bound into port.

The common cruising ground of the Pilot boats is off Clock Island and Nomans Land and frequently they extend their range at sea as far as the south side of Long Island and Nantucket. Open sailboats with branch pilots also cruise near Cuttyhunk Island, in order to assist vessels coming into the Western passage.

It is expected that if any of the Branch Pilots above named shall during any portion of the summer or winter months engage in any other business which may prevent them from acting as Pilots, that they will return their commissions to the Wardens of the Port.
